Treasurer Glynda Westerbeek presented the 2018-19 PTSA budget with one amendment. An adjustment of \$34 was made to Donation Income and Program Expenses-Teacher of the Year to cover the cost of signage.

- The budget was approved by unanimous vote.

#### Principal's Report

Principal Stephen Mares discussed current enrollment (2,098 students) and scheduling changes designed to better serve student needs and address capacity issues and safety.

- Advantage Time –extended periods to offer subject specific support for students
- Two lunches implemented to alleviate crowding/safety concerns and allows club/org meeting time.

He announced that ADMHS is fully staffed and off to a good start during this first week of school. He addressed continuing efforts to secure the school and improve safety of the students. WCPSS is currently working to complete installation of door locks with fob access. The front door to the Public Library will remain unlocked, but public access to student hallways will be prevented with a locking system. The floor was opened for questions.

### **Committee Reports**

Lysa Fulbright discussed open 2018-19 PTSA positions and responsibilities. Students were encouraged to join the PTSA to enhance their high school experience, cover service hours and strengthen college applications.

- Tricia Pannill explained the Backpack Buddies program and current needs.
- Lysa Fulbright reviewed the Parent Partners program.
